In expungement matters, pursuant to the Supreme Court's April 2, 2024 rule relaxation order (order and accompanying notice attached), attorneys effective May 1, 2024 may appear, substitute or withdraw from representation without leave of court and without the payment of any fee. An attorney who is substituting into or withdrawing from an expungement matter must have the consent of the parties and must use the electronic Expungement Portal to complete the appearance, substitution, or withdrawal. The necessary updates to the portal have been made consistent with the effective date.

The Court's pecifically relaxed Rules 1:11-2, 3:30-1, and 3:30-2. The Court's action significantly alters the process for entering an appearance, substitution, or withdrawal in an expungement. As such, please ensure that everyone who handles expungements regularly is aware of this Notice and Order and the corresponding system enhancements. This would include Criminal court staff, your ombudsman, your county bar association, and other stakeholders. You should share with them the notice and order as well as the attached electronic Expungement Portal Release Notes. Please note that both the external and internal versions of the Release Notes are attached, with directions as to which groups should receive which version.

#### NOTICE TO THE BAR

# EXPUNGEMENTS -- RELAXATION OF COURT RULES TO FACILITATE ATTORNEY APPEARANCES, SUBSTITUTIONS, AND WITHDRAWALS

Attorneys, including many who volunteer their services, provide invaluable assistance to people seeking expungements. To support those attorneys and their clients, the Supreme Court has formalized certain expungement procedures so as to permit attorneys to appear, substitute, or withdraw as counsel in expungement matters with the consent of the parties (1) without leave of court and (2) without the payment of fees.

The Court's Order relaxing Rules 1:11-2 ("Withdrawal or Substitution") 3:30-1 ("Expungement of Records") and 3:30-2 ("Expungements for Marijuana / Hashish Offenses, Recovery Court, Dismissals / Acquittals, and Clean Slate") is attached. The relaxation of the Court Rules is effective May 1, 2024.

#### SUPREME COURT OF NEW JERSEY

Pursuant to N.J. Const. art. VI, sec. 2, para. 3, IT IS ORDERED that effective May 1, 2024, the provisions of Rules 1:11-2 ("Withdrawal or Substitution"), 3:30-1 ("Expungement of Records"), and 3:30-2 ("Expungements for Marijuana/Hashish Offenses, Recovery Court, Dismissals/Acquittals, and Clean Slate") of the Rules Governing the Courts of the State of New Jersey are relaxed and supplemented as follows:

- 1. Rule 1:11-2(a) shall not apply to the entry, withdrawal, or substitution of counsel in petitions for expungement consistent with Rule 3:30-1 and Rule 3:30-2. All entries, withdrawals, and substitutions of appearance of counsel in expungement petitions may be filed at any time, without leave of court and with the consent of all parties, using the appropriate judiciary electronic court system and without payment of a fee.
- 2. Rule 3:30-1 and Rule 3:30-2 are supplemented to include that all entries, withdrawals, and substitutions of appearance of counsel in expungement petitions may be filed at any time, without leave of court and with the consent of all parties, using the appropriate judiciary electronic court system and without payment of a fee.

The provisions of this Order shall remain in effect pending development and adoption of conforming rule amendment or until further Order.




Figure 1. New Case Representation Tile



Once the Attorney clicks on Case Representation and searches a case, if that case does not have an attorney associated, they will see two options:

- Associate myself to case
- Assign another attorney from my office to case.

**Figure 2. Associate or Substitute Attorney Options** 




When selecting "Associate myself to case," verification text displays.

**Figure 3. Associate Self Options** 




When selecting "Assign another attorney from my office to case," a list of attorneys that match the Attorney's office ID displays. Once an attorney is selected, the verification text appears, and the user will be able to confirm selection.

If another attorney from your firm is already assigned to a petition, another attorney from your firm can be assigned to that petition. In this case, the only option that will appear is the Assign another attorney from my office to case. The selection options appear as well as the verification and confirm button.

When a selection is made and you click "Confirm," you'll navigate back to the Confirmation screen and will have the option to add another attorney or close the tile. A case jacket entry

is added to the case jacket and an email notification is sent as well. For amending orders, on the Attorney of Record, or anyone from their firm, will be able to amend that order.

**Figure 6. Attorney Association Completion notice** 




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## Substitution of Attorney Process Using the Case Representation Tile



Figure 7. Substitute of Attorney Options



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## County and Central Public Defender Notification Emails

County and Central Public Defenders will receive an email when they file an expungement, when a petition is returned, and various events about the case. Notification emails will be stored in the Case Jacket to review. The following are the events that trigger an email notification:


- Expungement Petition Filed or Revised
- Amended Expungement Petition is Filed or Revised
- Prosecutor submits a response to the Petition or an Amended Proposed Order
- Prosecutor returns the Petition to the Petitioner or an Amended Proposed Order
- Court Staff/Judge provides a Judicial Decision
- Court Staff/Judge provides a Granted Judicial Decision for Amended Order
- A Petition is Withdrawn
- Court Staff modifies the case status from "Pending Prosecutor review" to "Pending Petitioner Response"
- Court Staff modifies the case status from "Revised Petition Prosecutor Review" to "Pending Petitioner Response"
- Hearing Date Scheduled

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#### Self-Represented Litigant's (Pro Se) Process Flow Updates


Self-represented litigants will now retain their submitted expungement petitions once returned by the Prosecutor, unless they consent to allow the County Public Defender to represent them on the expungement case. If a prosecutor returns the petition, the self-represented litigant will see the 'Open' button enabled and be able to work on the petition.

On the Verification screen, a self-represented litigant will be able to select an option consenting to allow County Public Defender to handle the expungement petition if the petition is returned by the Prosecutor. By selecting the checkbox, the County Public Defender can assign themselves to the case if the petition is returned.

If the petition is returned, email notifications are sent to the corresponding County Public Defender's generic email as well as the self-represented litigant with the consent, either yes or no, and contact information so the County Public Defender can contact the user regarding their expungement petition.

Figure 14. New Workbasket Fields




Figure 15. Fields added to the Columns of the Workbasket


Figure 16. New Attorney of Record details on Additional Details Modal



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
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
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
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
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


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


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#### **Figure 8. Docket Text Entry**

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



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


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


